


JUDGMENT

Comes Now, a Judgment and Order by the Human Rights Tribunal,

WHEREAS, the tort claimant has claimed within the evidence submitted to this tribunal that the State of Tennessee (hereinafter “*tortfeasor*”) is determined to be the tortfeasor, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the evidence of the actions of the State of Tennessee on 12-09-2014 and filed with the Human Rights Tribunal that the tortfeasor did knowingly, intentionally and willfully commit human rights violations in the form of Human Trafficking against the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and

WHEREAS, the tort claimant has no intention of bringing suit before any quasi third party Article III court of the United States due to the fact that the State of Tennessee does not have any citizens of record in any court of common law. The State of Tennessee does have U.S. citizens that reside in the State of Tennessee as resident aliens which does not qualify as a permanent population. Therefore the Human Rights Tribunal organized under Article 8 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights is the only proper jurisdiction and venue in this case, and

WHEREAS, the tortfeasor, in an obvious attempt to avoid any Human Rights Violations, decided on 12-09-2014 to traffic Dutch Earl Thompson into residency of the State of Tennessee and U.S. citizen, thereby attempting to reverse an issue already settled between the U.S. and The United States of America, and

WHEREAS, Dutch Earl Thompson was forced to return to a court of the State of Tennessee through under threat of Human Trafficking and was told by the Government of The United States of America to act courteously towards the foreigners, do not be rude, and with the paperwork that was already sent to the State of Tennessee, The United States of America was hoping that there were non-violent, educated people running the State of Tennessee. The United States of America was wrong in its assumptions and realized that there were still slavery thinking minds in this generation like the generations before, and


THEREFORE, The United States of America hereby charges that the State of Tennessee has willfully, intentionally and with malice violated Article 1 through 30 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights that the State of Tennessee is a subject thereof and a party thereto through the U.S. signature of 1948, and

BE IT JUDGED, that the tort claimant's claim that human rights violations have in fact occurred, is correct, and

ORDER

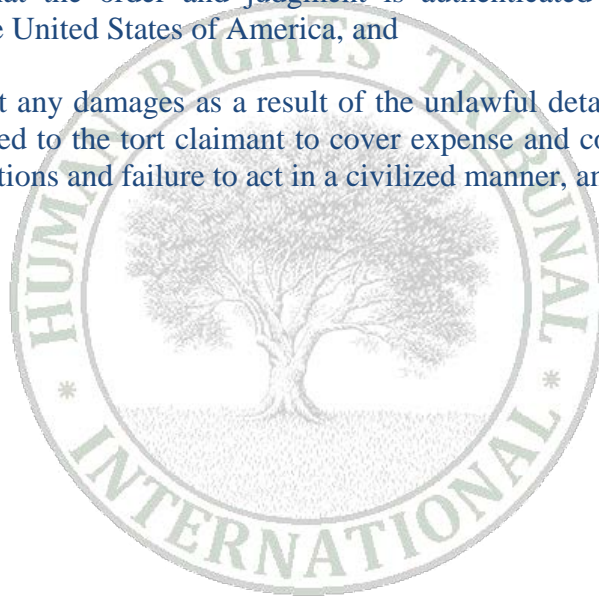
BE IT ORDERED, that Dutch Earl Thompson is released back to The United States of America, and

BE IT ORDERED, that the tortfeasor will cease and desist all contact with Dutch Earl Thompson directly or indirectly through others to cure the violations of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and

BE IT ORDERED, that any and all contract signed by Dutch Earl Thompson shall not be honored under any circumstances and are considered null and void, fraud under coercion. The United States of America does not negotiate with any private mafia association nor buckle under mafia tactics of the State of Tennessee Judicial System, and

BE IT ORDERED, that the order and judgment is authenticated through apostille of the Secretary of State of The United States of America, and

BE IT ORDERED, that any damages as a result of the unlawful detainment in the future shall be automatically rewarded to the tort claimant to cover expense and cost that may arise directly out of the tortfeasor's actions and failure to act in a civilized manner, and
