

## **AFFIDAVIT OF FACT**

Comes now, Jessica M. Garcia, (hereinafter "Affiant"). Being competent to testify, after first being duly sworn according to law to tell the truth to the facts related herein, Affiant has firsthand knowledge of the facts stated herein and believes these facts to be true to the best of Affiant's knowledge and belief.

### **Statement of Fact**

1. On Thursday August 18, 2016, Affiant renewed Affiant's vehicle registration and driver license at the West Covina, California Department of Motor Vehicles. Affiant placed the new 2017 vehicle tag in the proper location of the license plate before exiting the Department of Motor Vehicles parking lot. Affiant's vehicle license plate number is 6ZRZ207. Derek William Davidson, serving as Trustee for the DEREK WILLIAM DAVIDSON, PMA (hereinafter "Trustee"), drove the vehicle.
2. After running errands, Affiant and Trustee headed north on Vernon Avenue, crossing the bridge over the 210 Freeway, in the City of Azusa. Just past First Street, Affiant and Trustee passed a City of Azusa SUV patrol vehicle heading the opposite direction on Vernon Avenue. Trustee stopped at the stop sign. The patrol vehicle entered the right hand turn lane to enter the 210 freeway westbound. The patrol vehicle then made a deliberate U-turn in the intersection and stopped at the stop sign traveling northbound. The patrol vehicle was now behind Affiant's car. Trustee made an eastbound turn onto Fourth Street, the patrol car followed. Trustee then turned north onto Orange Avenue and the patrol vehicle made the same turn. After Trustee turned onto Fifth Street, the patrol vehicle turned on the red and blue lights, signaling Trustee to pull over. Trustee pulled over; one block away from Affiant's house, directly in front of Slauson Middle School's main entrance, on, or about, 3:00 p.m. Trustee did not exceed the posted speed limit during the time the patrol vehicle was following Trustee.
3. Officer Tremblay, City of Azusa Police Department, #001106, hereinafter "Respondent #1" proceeds to view the bottom left side of Affiant's vehicle's windshield. Respondent #1 asked Trustee for license, insurance and registration. Trustee informed Respondent #1 that Trustee is not the registered owner of the vehicle and handed Respondent #1 Trustee's International Translation of National Driver Permit card and corresponding booklet. Affiant gave Respondent #1 Affiant's current registration and insurance and identified Affiant as the registered owner of the vehicle. Respondent #1 gathered all documents and took them to Respondent #1's patrol car. Seven to ten minutes later, Respondent #1 returned to Affiant's side of Affiant's vehicle. Respondent #1 requested Affiant's identification. Affiant gave Respondent #1 a Sonoma County badge from Affiant's former employer. Respondent #1 stated that Respondent #1 wanted to confirm that Affiant lived in Sonoma County. Affiant told Respondent #1 that Affiant no longer lives in Sonoma County and had recently moved back to Southern California. Respondent #1 requested that Affiant exit the vehicle. Affiant and Respondent #1 moved away from the vehicle. Respondent #1 stated that the reason Respondent #1 pulled the car over was because the tags came up expired when Respondent #1 ran the license plate. Affiant pointed out that the tags were current and on the license plate

and that valid documents were in Respondent #1's hands. Respondent #1 acted as if Respondent #1 was confused stating, "Usually the DMV database updates at the time of payment."

4. Then, Respondent #1 shifted the topic and the following conversation occurred:

Respondent #1: "Who is this guy?"

Affiant: "That is my boyfriend".

Respondent #1: "How long have you known him?"

Affiant: "Less than a year, about eight months".

Respondent #1: "How long have you two been dating?"

Affiant: "About 8 months".

Respondent #1: "Was he a heavy set guy before?"

Affiant responded that Trustee had mentioned that before.

Respondent #1: "You do know what he is into, right?"

Affiant: "Well yes, he is my boyfriend".

Respondent #1: "People like him are dangerous, you know that right?"

Affiant: "No. I'm not sure what you are talking about".

Respondent #1: "People like him have this false reality. They think that they don't have to abide by our rules. They think they are above the law. See that stop sign over there"?

Affiant: "Yes".

Respondent #1: "They think they don't have to stop because they don't need to follow our rules".

Affiant: "That's not true. He stops at every stop sign. He knows the traffic laws".

Respondent #1: "People like that are unpredictable. Who knows what he will stop at?"

You know that he is going to continue to get in trouble right? He was recently arrested in Glendora for being under the influence”.

**Affiant:** “Actually, the Glendora incident was his first time ever being in trouble”.

**Respondent #1:** “Well it’s not going to end here. He will keep on getting in trouble as long as he thinks our laws don’t matter. Well anyway, he has a \$30,000 warrant out for his arrest”.

**Respondent #1:** Then asked his partner to go, “chain him up”.

**Respondent #1:** Then asked Affiant to step further back and hang tight.

**Respondent #1:** Asked partner go to the driver’s side of Affiant’s car. Trustee exits the car. Trustee is handcuffed and put into the patrol vehicle.

**Respondent #1:** Returns to Affiant and apologizes for the inconvenience.

**Affiant:** Asked if it was a possibility that Trustee might be released the same night.

**Respondent #1:** Replied no.

**Affiant:** Asked if Trustee will see a judge the following day.

**Respondent #1:** Stated most likely, depending on how quickly Trustee is booked at the station.

5. Respondent #1 then continues conversation with Affiant:

**Respondent #1:** “What’s up with him? Do you know?”

**Affiant:** “What do you mean?”

**Respondent #1:** “He is not all there is he?”

**Affiant:** “What do you mean?”

**Respondent #1:** “What he is saying, I don’t know, he is not all there is he?”

**Affiant:** “What do you mean? That’s my boyfriend. Yes he is”.

**Respondent #1:** “Well, you are going to do what you want to do. People like him are dangerous. Whether he is worth it is up to you. But I’m telling you now who knows what it will take to stop him. Maybe it’ll be him getting arrested. Maybe it will be domestic violence. Who knows? I personally

think you could do better. That's up to you. Again, sorry for the inconvenience".

Affiant's paperwork was returned by Respondent #1. Affiant was not cited and Affiant drove home.

The affiant further sayeth naught.
