THE COURT: Mr. Mohlman?

MR. MOHLMAN: Yes, ma'am.

THE COURT: Why don't you come sit over here.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Sit over here, sir.

THE COURT: Right over here.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Come around here and sit in the chair right here.

THE COURT: And sir--sit over here Mr. Mohlman right now. Sir in the second row with the black shirt, with the white collar, please stand up. Please stand up sir.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Sit down.

MR. MOHLMAN: Am I being detained?

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Yes.

MR. MOHLMAN: I'm being detained?

THE COURT: Sit down sir, know.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Right there.

THE COURT: Sir, stand up, in the second row.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Sir, stand up.

MR. SCHIED: I did stand up.

OFFICER SCHIPANI: Stand up.

THE COURT: State your name?

MR. SCHIED: (No verbal response).

1 THE COURT: State your name?

2 MR. SCHIED: (No verbal response).

3 THE COURT: The person that's in front of the
4 Court, who's refusing to state his name, will be held in
5 contempt and jailed for 30 days. Have a seat or go with--
6 Officer Butler, just take him out. I think I need some
7 help over here.

8 OFFICER SCHIPANI: Sir, where you going?

9 THE COURT: Sir.

10 OFFICER SCHIPANI: Come here.

11 THE COURT: I've got like six or seven moors--you
12 can--you can arrest him and take him into custody.

13 (At 10:15 a.m., Mr. Schied being handcuffed)

14 THE COURT: You can just put him in the lockup.

15 OFFICER STRONG: I can walk him over, Your Honor.

16 THE COURT: Yeah, that might help. I just don't
17 want him to be here by himself.

18 OFFICER STRONG: All right.

19 THE COURT: And I've got this one here that's
20 next. Sir, in the second row, would you please stand up
21 and state your name.

22 MR. KELLER: My name is Ron Keller.

23 THE COURT: Mr. Keller, what are you here for?

24 MR. KELLER: I came here to observe this--um--
25 case with Mr. Mohlman.

1 THE COURT: Do you know who the person is that's
2 in the lockup right now?

3 MR. KELLER: Ah--yes, I do.

4 THE COURT: Who is that?

5 MR. KELLER: It's David Schied.

6 THE COURT: And do you know if there's anybody
7 else here with this group this morning?

8 MR. KELLER: With this group?

9 THE COURT: Yeah, with your--is--is there anyone
10 else that came here with you and Mr. Schied?

11 MR. KELLER: I didn't come here with Mr. Schied.

12 THE COURT: Is there anyone else--anyone else
13 that's here in your group?

14 MR. KELLER: There's no group.

15 THE COURT: Is there anyone else that's here for
16 the Mohlman hearing, to your knowledge?

17 MR. KELLER: Um--as far as I know--um--maybe some
18 of these other people here are observing.

19 THE COURT: Sir, in the red shirt, stand up.
20 What's your name?

21 MR. LISS: Michael Liss.

22 THE COURT: Okay. Are you here for this hearing?

23 MR. LISS: I don't know what hearing.

24 THE COURT: Mr. Mohlman's hearing?

25 MR. LISS: Yes, I'm here for that.

1 THE COURT: Okay. Have a seat. Sir, are you
2 here for this hearing?

3 OFFICER SCHIPANI: Stand up, sir.

4 THE COURT: Please state your name?

5 MR. LONIER: Am I being charged with something?

6 THE COURT: I just want to know what your name
7 is, sir. I have to control the courtroom and I have the
8 sense that there's something going on here that I need to
9 be aware of. So, under the court rules if you're not going
10 to give me your name I'm going to hold you in contempt.

11 MR. LONIER: I have no contempt for this Court.

12 THE COURT: I just need for you to tell me what
13 your name is, sir.

14 MR. LONIER: David--David.

15 THE COURT: What's your last name, sir?

16 MR. LONIER: Lonier, L-o-n-i-e-r.

17 THE COURT: Okay. You can have a seat--

18 MR. LONIER: And I give you the information under
19 duress.

20 THE COURT: Have your--have a seat.

21 MR. LONIER: For fear of my--my personal safety.

22 THE COURT: Have a seat.

23 MR. LONIER: Thank you.

24 OFFICER SCHIPANI: (Inaudible).

25 MR. KING: Stephen(phonetically) King, I'm here

1 for Cynthia Pelletier.

2 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Is there anyone
3 else that's here on the Mohlman hearing? What's your name.

4 MS. JENNING: Anna.

5 THE COURT: Anna what?

6 MS. JENNING: Anna Jennings.

7 THE COURT: Okay. Have a seat. You're more than
8 welcome to come in and observe at any time, but I have the
9 sense that there's something more going on here and I--I
10 have an obligation under the court rules to control the
11 court proceedings in the courtroom. And so, if you do not
12 cooperate when asked in a courtroom, you're subject to the
13 contempt orders of the Court. You can take Mr. Schied
14 over.
