Thus concluding in an arbitrary manner, The Interdependence Assemblies, their concluding consultation, and Convocation will provide the initial 1976 program agenda for the Bicentennial era paralleling the thirteen years matching the period between 1776 and final adoption of the U.S. Constitution in 1789. Therefore, usurpation is in play in The United States upon the people, and any changes made are a nullity, made against the born here and immigrated Americans.

Therefore, these foreign devices applied, and Wic claims that the creature states are operating, have been changing the government, and below shows use of force by unlawful means by use of foreign Associations, and Political Constituency, violating article of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as shown:

Article 2

Is claimed as violation that Socialist Communist have changed the governments operation by pledges by C.E.O. Of the United States, Inc., and in lower courts, without treaty, and above constitutions, subjected Wic to his rights and freedom as was originally designed in government with status, property and distinction of choice, all affected internationally in an unlawful device.

Article 3

Is claimed as violation that the state of North Carolina courts and its non-agencies of private corporation have damaged Wic's security of person, threatening his life and liberty.

Article 4

Is claimed as violation that the political constituency is nothing more than a device to use bonds in a monetization scheme to facade a monetary slavery.

Article 8

Is claimed as violation as no court exist when trafficking is implemented under a norm.

Article 9

Is claimed as violation as was arrested and detained, when not part of state of North Carolina courts or state of North Carolina Department of Transportation.

Article 15

(1) Is claimed as violation as Wic was interfered with as his right to a Nationality, and his Nationality was changed by Socialist Communist of the 1930's era, and the Declaration of Interdependence of 1976 by the mostly Democratic Internationalist in Congress, and
(2) Is a device to deprive an individual non-person his Nationality.

Article 17

(1) Is claimed as violation as Wic can own tangible or intangible property, not subject to the state of North Carolina or of state of North Carolina Department of Transportation, and
(2) Is claimed as violation as Wic was deprived of his intangible rights to travel and not interfered with by Police mercenaries or Municipal guards.

Article 18

Is claimed as violation as Wic can have freedom of religion, and the state of North Carolina courts, can not force the Catholic religion and Free Mason brand with its associations and charters or force Wic into the Public Safety and Welfare domain.

Article 20

Is claimed as violation as Wic can not be compelled to belong to an association as a Societal or Socialist or Communist Political Constituency, under the state of North Carolina or state of North Carolina Department of Transportation.

CLAIMS

Unknown Identify of Police/Guards/Mercenary in Municipal Charging Instruments.
Generalities to Jurisdiction ignore the actual location is unknown what capacity of Jurisdiction.
The CONCORD POLICE DEPARTMENT and HM PARRISH/HOBBIE PARRISH are a Municipal Charter from the parent state and is an Association and/or Charter thus are a Political Constituency. That **Glenn Whicker Neal JR** is not part of, and the parent State of North Carolina operates under foreign constitution of a different Political Constituency.
That the court systems are under this different Political Constituency, typically branded by the Free Mason symbol of the compass on most Federal and State buildings, which is associated to Papal and Vatican, which are Ecclesiastical courts of a foreign entity and a different and foreign religion to **Glenn Whicker Neal JR**, thus the courts are forcing their religious or moral or Political Constituency upon **Glenn Whicker Neal JR**, and ignore the Acardi doctrine to falsely claim jurisdiction, that is not consistent from the Congressional records and/or Federal Registry thus changing those laws from a People decision into a court order of force by some other Political Constituency, and vacating his Political Constituency from **Glenn Whicker Neal JR** and substituting another or foreign instrument for force. These are further indicated by the American Bar administrating forced America Bar Association upon non-members such as **Glenn Whicker Neal JR**.
These foreign Ecclesiastical courts use foreign constitutions or chartered constitutions and article of something else and simulate a law process to force **Glenn Whicker Neal JR**, into a process when even when claimed and advised to contrary.
