## **AFFIDAVIT OF TRUTH**

### **DECLARATION OF EXISTENCE OF HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS**

**COMES NOW**, Glenn Whicker Neal, Jr., (Hereinafter "Affiant") (Resident # 744038758095) being competent to testify and being over the age of 21 years, after first being duly sworn according to law to tell the truth to the facts related herein to declare the existence of Human Rights Violations as follows:

1. Affiant was in a vehicle on the roads of the City of Concord in Cabarrus County, North Carolina when approached by Officer Hobbie Parrish (Hereinafter "Respondent") of the Concord Police Department.
2. Affiant did not harm any other person or property. Affiant was clearly attending to one's own affairs.
3. Respondent further made accusations against Affiant such as follows:
  - a. Tampering with the vehicle VIN Number.
  - b. Displaying an altered tag and knowing the same to be false.
  - c. Failing to carry a valid North Carolina driver's license.
  - d. Using a fake name.
  - e. Failing to have a license to inspect vehicles, which later was changed to Failure to have vehicle inspected.
4. Respondent ask for driver's license and registration. Affiant objected due to the vehicle was plainly marked as PRIVATE mode of travel and Affiant was not engaged in any form of commerce.
5. Respondent asked for Affiant's name and Affiant's gave Respondent the name his mother and father gave him at birth, and the same being the name used to refer to Affiant every day of his life by all who know him.
6. Respondent called for backup producing an additional eight Concord City Police Officers.
7. One of the backup Respondents threatened to break Affiant's window.
