Now being removed from the free exercise of his liberty the Aggrieved was brought before another unknown man who was acting as a police officer at a desk in a building believed to be Methuen Police Department; the Aggrieved asked the second man, in good faith, to see the alleged warrant with an attached Oath to prove the validity of arresting allegations against the Aggrieved's person; the unknown man, title of Sergeant, chuckled, looked at the ID and said something to the effect of, "American National, OK," then pointed to the computer screen saying, there's the warrant; and further, the man proceeded to say a bail commissioner would get the information when he shows up; and further,

the Aggrieved believes that no legitimate warrant exists; and further, no one ever showed up with any information that evidenced a valid warrant but rather a complete disregard for it; and further,

the Aggrieved was stripped of his person, his shoes, belt, coat, other possessions, and effects, he was taken by the arm into a jail cell where there was only a metal slab and steel toilet and white lights on all the time. Seven or eight hours overnight the Aggrieved froze and it was torturous he begged for a blanket, tissue a pillow or even to restore his shoes and coat but the Aggrieved was given nothing, he was told, "Jail it is not supposed to be comfortable and that he would have to deal with it"; and further,

dealing with it he tried to sleep but spent the night awake on a freezing metal slab with a constant white light glaring at his eyes; and further,

lacking sleep the Aggrieved was exhausted and dizzy the next day and further,

13th November about 7AM the Aggrieved, who's effect and possessions were not restored, was shackled and put into a van then taken to another building and placed in another cell (later found he was brought to Laurence Courthouse) ; and further,
