



15 November 6AM the Aggrieved, again, shackled, and in bondage then trafficked over to a place, this time, known as Woburn District Court where he was caged and brought again before a woman acting as judge or administrator or magistrate, the Aggrieved was uncertain because he was never told who anyone's title was; and further, said woman/judge, named Marianne Hinkle (herein after, Hinkle) , spoke to the Aggrieved and asking what do you have to say, the Aggrieved answered: "i was hoping we could talk man to man", i, man, am innocent and stand upon the good faith documents sent here that you should have in your possession; and further, i have never dishonored this court; and further, i have written something for the record by hand"; the Aggrieved attempted give the hand-written paper to her, Hinkle said read it aloud, so the Aggrieved having no other choice, as he was still in bondage, read the paper on to the record in open voice (See Exhibit C); and further,

Hinkle looked over at the two people who were sitting as plaintiff and asked: do you have anything to say? Which they then replied: "no"; and further,

Hinkle said:" i am going to assign you an attorney but the Aggrieved did not accept, replying: I am unaware of any law that requires I accept said services; and further,

this happened three times and the Aggrieved repeated himself, three times; and further,

Hinkle proclaimed with superiority: i don't believe you are competent to stand trial" and i am going to have our doctor (who just so happened to be in the court room waiting) evaluate you; and further,

the Aggrieved again in a holding cage when a woman, unknown name showed up to say she was a Doctor and was ordered by the Judge to evaluate the Aggrieved; and further,

the Aggrieved informed her that would be unnecessary as a private Competency Evaluation exists; and further [my] expert doctor who is world-renowned in the field can tender it into the matter; and further, woman, doctor (name unknown) said will you sign release for us to talk with him and the Aggrieved said YES and did without prejudice; and further,
