This is the email response I received from the man DCF acting supervisor in for my son. I wrote about seeing my son offering private supervision due to conflict of interest the other day and copied you on the email. I thought you should have a copy of his response.

David,

The matter of custody of your son Dylan is before the Cambridge Juvenile Court.

They will determine whether to terminate your parental rights to Dylan. There is no other jurisdiction in this case. Your son will not be returned to you anytime soon as you have not been to court or shown interest in visiting with him.

I know you just told me you are not interested in visits.

However, you are welcome to a supervised visit in the area office.

You do not have to do any of the tasks we or the court asked of you to have the visit.

You don't have to attend court or do anything else as you have a right to visit your son.

You don't have to agree with us about our perceptions and we don't need to have any discussion.

You can simply come and visit your son. It will be supervised by me. As before I will not be in the room with you but will be present for the visit.
